

To the Ohio Senate Energy Committee:

I am writing to urge you to oppose Senate Bill 294. This proposal would prioritize polluting gas projects while making it harder for affordable solar and wind energy to compete—undermining both climate progress and consumer choice.

SB 294 also wrongly labels fracked gas as “clean,” despite the fracking process releasing methane, a greenhouse gas that is far more potent than carbon dioxide. Promoting fossil fuel infrastructure under the guise of clean energy risks locking communities into higher emissions and higher long-term costs.

Our state should be investing in truly clean, affordable energy solutions that protect public health, strengthen local economies, and move us toward a sustainable future—not giving polluting projects an unfair advantage.

Please vote NO on SB 294 and support policies that accelerate genuine renewable energy.
