The All in For Ohio Kids Coalition (AOK) formed in 2021 to ensure that every child in Ohio – no matter their race, zip code, or how much money their family has – can attend a great public school that prepares them for a bright future.

AOK is anchored by the Ohio Education Association, the Ohio Federation of Teachers, the Ohio Organizing Collaborative, and Policy Matters Ohio. We cheered the General Assembly for its decision to begin phasing in the Fair School Funding Plan in the 2022-23 state budget. We are committed to seeing the plan fully implemented in the 2026-27 state budget, as lawmakers promised four years ago.

Ohio School Board Members Call on State Legislators and Governor DeWine to Fully Fund Ohio's Public Schools Through the Fair School Funding Plan

We, the undersigned members of local school boards across Ohio, respectfully urge you to support the full and ongoing implementation of the Fair School Funding Plan (FSFP) using current research-based inputs that reflect today's educational and economic realities.

The FSFP represents a bipartisan effort to address the long-standing constitutional mandate to provide a thorough and efficient system of public education for Ohio's students. Developed with input from educators, finance experts, and legislators across party lines, the formula is working as intended. It calculates the actual cost to educate each child, district by district, and provides an equitable and transparent foundation for a shared responsibility between the state and local communities to support public education for the nearly 90% of Ohio students attending public schools.

The 134th General Assembly took historic action to adopt the FSFP into law, establishing a six-year phase-in that would bring Ohio closer to a stable, equitable, and constitutionally sound funding model. This plan was never intended to be static—it requires regular updates to ensure accuracy and responsiveness to changing conditions in our schools and communities. Full funding of this formula is essential to ensure that every student in Ohio, regardless of ZIP code, receives the educational opportunities they need and deserve.

Alarmingly, provisions in the current state budget for FY 2026-2027 threaten the integrity of the FSFP, leaving many districts, especially those with limited local tax bases, struggling to meet rising

costs and educational demands. These changes risk stalling progress, undermining the formula's effectiveness, and disrupting local school districts' ability to plan responsibly for the long term. Without continued commitment and full funding, our ability to meet the needs of students—and to uphold our shared constitutional duty—is compromised.

We also urge you to honor the essential principle of local control. Locally elected school boards are accountable to our communities and are best equipped to provide responsive and fiscally sound governance. This includes maintaining local control over cash balances, ensuring districts can manage reserves responsibly to address future needs, and determining the timing and amount of necessary levies in response to local circumstances. Preserving local decision-making is vital to maintaining the trust of the public and our school districts' long-term stability.

Ohio has a once-in-a-generation opportunity to fulfill the promise of a funding system that is student-centered, needs-based, and constitutionally sound. We respectfully ask for your leadership in fully funding the Fair School Funding Plan with up-to-date inputs and preserving the critical role of local governance in public education.
