I am submitting testimony in opposition to SB96, the policy to discontinue Medicaid expansion in Ohio.

I relied on Medicaid for about a year during a transitional period of my life. I was between jobs and piecing together part-time work, none of which offered health insurance. I was struggling emotionally and relied on mental health counseling and medication to keep me safe and healthy. Regular doctor and dentist appointments also helped keep me physically well.

I was able to get off Medicaid after securing full-time employment with benefits including health care. I was building my life back up, and several years later I was accepted into the MBA program at Fisher College at the Ohio State University, where I graduated with honors.

None of that would have been possible without the support I received during that challenging time, including free mental and physical health services through Medicaid.

Every Ohioan deserves the same support and opportunities I received. Usually if a person needs Medicaid, they are already struggling in at least one area of their life. Let's not kick them when they're down.
