

**Opponent Testimony for SB 1**

My name is Callie Buchanan (she/her), and I am a fourth-year Political Science and International Affairs student at the University of Cincinnati. As a student at a public university, I am submitting this testimony in opposition to SB 1.

I have lived in the state of Ohio my entire life. When I was graduating from high school, I specifically selected a university that valued its diverse student population and wanted to help all students, no matter their race, gender, or socioeconomic status, become professional adults in society. This is why I chose UC as well as why I chose a school in Ohio.

During my time in school, the classes and trainings I have participated in have given me a space to hear from those with many beliefs and opinions. Being in a community of learners with others has helped me to open my mind to new perspectives, even when I disagree with what they have to say.

I have only benefited from training and programming related to DEI. They have made me a more welcoming person, especially to those with ideas different from my own.
