Chair Roegner, Vice Chair Cirino, Ranking Member Ingram, and members of the Senate Higher Education Committee,

Thank you for allowing me to testify. My name is Christie Lukegord and I have been employed within higher education for my career but write to you as a private citizen. I am strongly opposed to SB 1 and its companion bill HB 6.

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion are not just a few buzz words that are publicized in the media.
