Thank you for allowing me to testify. My name is Laurie Albright. I am a recently retired School Psychologist, having worked in the public schools for 47 years. I am strongly opposed to SB 1 and its companion bill HB 6.

This bill would make it impossible to teach the history we all must understand if we have any hope of not repeated past tragedies, such as the Holocaust. I truly do not understand the motivation to remove topics from collective bargaining, and banning teachers from participating in work strikes. Without serious revision this bill will damage Ohio's ability to attract good staff, and make a mockery of what higher education is all about.
