This bill wrongly aims to punish faculty for having their own personal beliefs and ideological ideals. Republican legislators want to respond to that rightful use of free speech by gutting collective bargaining rights, limiting academic freedom, and imposing onerous workload and evaluation policies that harm students, faculty, and our institutions of higher learning.

By stripping faculty of workload, tenure protections, and retrenchment policies, SB1 will halt educators ability to advocate for smaller classroom sizes, necessary facility improvements, and quality education, all of which will directly and negatively impact student success.
