## **INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 214 - Representative Miller, K.

To amend sections 1751.72, 3923.041, and 5160.34 and to enact section 5160.341 of the Revised Code to require the Medicaid program and certain health insurers to report data about prior authorization requirements and to require an exemption to such requirements for certain providers.

**H. B. No. 215** - Representatives Jarrells, Stephens. Cosponsors: Representatives Denson, Fischer, Mohamed, Upchurch, White, E.

To amend section 323.131 and to enact section 5705.17 of the Revised Code to prohibit most property tax levies submitted at a general election from taking effect in the current tax year.

H. B. No. 216 - Representatives Williams, Jarrells.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brennan, Brewer, Click, Daniels, Denson, Isaacsohn, Miller, K., McNally, Mohamed, Piccolantonio, Russo, Sims, Thomas, C., Upchurch.

To establish the 'A HAND UP' pilot program, to designate this act as the Actionable Help And New Dignity for Upward Progression (A HAND UP) Act, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 217 - Representatives Cockley, Ritter.

Cosponsors: Representatives Grim, Denson, Sigrist, Gross, Abdullahi, Miller, J., Brennan, Isaacsohn, Newman, Workman, White, E., Daniels, Odioso, Jarrells, Brewer, Synenberg, Rader.

To amend sections 2901.30, 2901.41, and 2901.42 of the Revised Code to enact the Finding and Identifying with NamUs Data (FIND) Act to require law enforcement agencies to enter information relating to a report of a missing person in the national missing and unidentified persons system (NamUs). H. B. No. 218 - Representatives Cockley, Salvo.

To amend section 4301.13 of the Revised Code to allow retail liquor permit holders to offer a discount on dealcoholized wine under specified circumstances.

H. B. No. 219 - Representative Deeter.

To enact section 3901.93 of the Revised Code to establish network adequacy standards for health insurers.

H. B. No. 220 - Representative Workman.

To amend sections 1751.72, 3923.041, and 5160.34 of the Revised Code regarding health insurance and Medicaid program prior authorization requirements.

H. B. No. 221 - Representatives Brennan, Synenberg.

Cosponsors: Representatives White, E., Rader, Gross, Brent, McNally, Russo, Mohamed, Robinson, Grim, Abdullahi, Sims, Isaacsohn, Hall, D., Lett, Glassburn, Sweeney, Cockley.

To enact section 5.266 of the Revised Code to designate April as "Arab American Heritage Month."

Said bills were considered the first time.
