INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 634 - Representatives Young, Kishman.

To amend section 3313.64 and to enact section 3313.5321 of the Revised Code regarding eligibility to participate in interscholastic athletics.

H. B. No. 635 - Representatives Plummer, Young.

Cosponsors: Representatives White, A., Workman, Johnson.

To amend sections 2151.412, 2151.421, 2151.423, 2151.429, 2151.467, 2151.468, 2903.01, 2903.11, 2919.22, 2929.13, 2929.14, 2941.1426, 5153.122, and 5153.16 and to enact sections 2151.4211, 2151.4235, 2151.89, and 5180.09 of the Revised Code to enact the Child Protection Reform Act.

H. B. No. 636 - Representative Johnson.

To amend section 1345.81 and to enact sections 3937.51, 3937.52, 3937.53, and 3937.54 of the Revised Code to require certain disclosures, allow consumer choice concerning the use of aftermarket motor vehicle parts, to require the offering of coverage for original equipment manufacturer parts, and to name this act the Auto Insurance Transparency Act.

H. B. No. 637 - Representative Mathews, T.

To enact section 3710.30 of the Revised Code to allow a person to use recycled asphalt roofing shingles for construction purposes so long as the shingles do not contain asbestos.

H. B. No. 638 - Representatives Swearingen, LaRe.

To enact section 5534.59 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of I-70 in Franklin County as the "President Donald Trump Freedom Highway."

Said bills were considered the first time.
