The House met pursuant to adjournment.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 425 - Representative Hoops.

To amend section 4561.50 and to enact section 4561.54 of the Revised Code to prohibit trespass and types of unauthorized recording with an unmanned aerial vehicle system.

H. B. No. 426 - Representatives Williams, Demetriou.

To amend section 169.01 and to enact sections 169.20, 169.21, 169.22, 169.23, 169.24, 169.25, and 169.26 of the Revised Code to provide for the safekeeping and management of unclaimed digital assets.

H. B. No. 427 - Representative Klopfenstein.

To amend section 4909.192 and to enact section 4928.106 of the Revised Code to authorize voluntary demand response programs for residential and small commercial customers.

H. B. No. 428 - Representatives Thomas, D., Williams.

Cosponsors: Representatives Click, King, Glassburn, Brennan.

To amend sections 735.01 and 737.01 of the Revised Code to remove residency requirements for the city director of public service and the city director of public safety.

H. B. No. 429 - Representative Hoops.

To amend section 3901.385 of the Revised Code to prohibit third-party payers from reducing reimbursement to health care providers based on certain factors.

H. B. No. 430 - Representatives Hiner, Miller, K.

To enact section 5534.451 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 13 in Knox County as the "Ohio State Highway Patrol Lt. Vance M. Andrews Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 431 - Representative Williams.

To amend sections 3314.03, 3326.11, and 3328.24 and to enact section 3313.675 of the Revised Code regarding human trafficking screening in

public schools and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 432 - Representatives Brownlee, Miller, K.

To enact section 5534.482 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of East Kemper Road in Hamilton County as the "Patrolman Earl W. Casterline Memorial Highway."

Said bills were considered the first time.
