Pursuant to House Rule No. 25, the Clerk called the House to order.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 205 - Representatives Brennan, Jones.

Cosponsors: Representatives White, E., Rader, Deeter, Piccolantonio, Williams, Sigrist, Daniels, Pizzulli, Isaacsohn, Miller, J., Rogers, Synenberg, Thomas, D., Manning, Denson, Mohamed, Baker, McNally, Somani, Upchurch, Click, Abrams, Robinson, Cockley, Hall, D.

To enact sections 3301.24, 3301.82, 3319.70, 3345.83, and 6301.113 of the Revised Code to enact the Future Educators Support Act regarding financial support for student teachers, teaching as an in-demand job, and school district staffing surveys.

H. B. No. 206 - Representatives Gross, McClain.

Cosponsors: Representatives Dean, Fischer, Ferguson, Demetriou, Lorenz, Ritter, Newman, King, Mullins, Lear.

To enact sections 113.81, 113.82, 113.83, 113.84, 113.85, 113.86, 113.87, 113.88, 113.89, and 113.90 of the Revised Code to establish a transactional currency based on gold and silver held in a bullion depository approved by the treasurer of state.

H. B. No. 207 - Representatives Lorenz, Rogers.

To enact sections 5.2322 and 5.2323 of the Revised Code to designate June as "Male Wellness Month" and the third Monday in June as "Take Your Dad to the Doctor Day."

H. B. No. 208 - Representative Lorenz.

Cosponsors: Representatives Johnson, Williams.

To amend section 2903.13 of the Revised Code to enact the Courtroom Employee Protection Act to increase the penalty for assault when the victim is a judge, magistrate, prosecutor, or court official or employee.

H. B. No. 209 - Representative Lorenz.

To amend sections 718.01, 5747.01, and 5748.01 of the Revised Code to exempt tips from state, municipal, and school district income taxes.

H. B. No. 210 - Representatives Roemer, Plummer.

To amend sections 2913.02, 2913.51, 4737.012, 4737.04, 4737.041, 4737.043, 4737.045, 4737.99, 4738.03, 4738.07, 4738.12, 4745.01, and 4775.09 and to enact sections 4737.046 and 4737.98 of the Revised Code regarding the sale of used catalytic converters.

H. B. No. 211 - Representatives Humphrey, Williams.

To amend sections 2929.19, 2951.03, and 2951.041 of the Revised Code to require a court to consider an offender's status as a primary caretaker of a child in determining whether the offender is amenable to a community control sanction or to intervention in lieu of conviction.

To amend sections 319.202, 319.302, 323.155, 323.158, 4503.0610, and 5323.02 and to enact sections 323.21 and 323.22 of the Revised Code to allow eligible homeowners to defer the payment of a portion of their property taxes.

H. B. No. 213 - Representatives Miller, K., Salvo.

To enact section 5534.926 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of Interstate 70 in Licking County as the "Tuscarawas Valley Memorial Highway."
