### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 668** - Representative King.

Cosponsors: Representatives Deeter, Gross, Salvo, Barhorst.

To amend sections 4773.01, 4773.02, 4773.03, and 4773.06 of the Revised Code to revise the law governing general X-ray machine operators and other radiation technicians.

**H. B. No. 669** - Representatives Miller, J., Brennan.

To amend section 3313.603 of the Revised Code to permit the AP Business with Personal Finance course to fulfill the high school financial literacy requirement.

**H. B. No. 670** - Representatives Russo, Robb Blasdel.

Cosponsors: Representatives Piccolantonio, Jarrells, Grim, Lett, Baker, Rader, Synenberg, Sweeney, Salvo, Upchurch, Brennan, Brewer, Brownlee, Sigrist, Odioso, White, E., Thomas, C.

To amend sections 2151.23, 2151.233, 2151.352, 3101.01, 3101.05, and 3109.011 and to repeal sections 3101.02, 3101.04, 3101.041, and 3101.042 of the Revised Code to repeal law that authorizes a person who is seventeen years of age to marry.

**H. B. No. 671** - Representative Callender.

To enact section 3317.50 of the Revised Code regarding school districts that bring a legal action against the state challenging the calculation and distribution of foundation funding and to make an appropriation.

**H. B. No. 672** - Representatives Klopfenstein, Peterson.

Cosponsors: Representatives Thomas, D., King, Claggett, Robb Blasdel, Williams, Workman, Salvo, Hoops, Ritter, Lorenz, Creech, Hiner, Ghanbari.

To amend section 5577.05 of the Revised Code to exempt a vehicle towing farm machinery from the statutory vehicle size limits.

**H. B. No. 673** - Representative Stephens.

To amend sections 323.152, 323.153, 323.156, 323.158, and 5747.85 of the Revised Code to expand the statewide owner-occupied residence property tax credit to all tax levies.

**H. B. No. 674** - Representative Miller, K.

To amend sections 3319.316 and 4511.76 and to enact sections 3327.103, 4925.11, 4925.12, 4925.13, and 4925.14 of the Revised Code to authorize a public or private school to transport students using a transportation network company.

**H. B. No. 675** - Representatives Stephens, Deeter.

To establish a temporary program for hospital payments made by Medicaid managed care organizations and to name this act the Healthier Rural Hospitals Act.

**H. B. No. 676** - Representatives Thomas, D., Creech.

Cosponsor: Representative Newman.

To amend sections 955.01, 955.024, and 955.11 and to enact sections 305.87, 955.025, 955.111, and 955.25 of the Revised Code to establish regulations regarding wolfdog hybrids and to allow a board of county commissioners to abate certain animal nuisances.

Said bills were considered the first time.
