The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 722** - Representative Bird.

To amend sections 4507.04 and 5502.11 of the Revised Code to prohibit a person without legal presence in the United States from driving in Ohio with an out-of-state license and to require the Attorney General to take certain enforcement actions.

**H. B. No. 723** - Representatives Klopfenstein, Miller, M.

Cosponsors: Representatives Williams, Thomas, D., Johnson, King, Newman, McClain.

To amend section 4117.10 and to enact section 4113.25 of the Revised Code to prohibit certain nondisclosure or confidentiality agreements regarding sexual abuse of a child.

**H. B. No. 724** - Representatives Salvo, White, A.

To enact section 3902.65 of the Revised Code to require a health benefit plan to provide coverage for annual behavioral health well checks.

**H. B. No. 725** - Representative Miller, K.

To enact section 4549.07 of the Revised Code to restrict the collection, use, sale, transfer, and sharing of data collected from an automated license plate recognition system for commercial purposes.

**H. B. No. 726** - Representative Demetriou.

To amend section 4141.29 of the Revised Code to waive the requirement that an unemployment claimant be actively seeking work under certain circumstances.

**H. B. No. 727** - Representatives Fischer, Plummer.

To amend sections 5139.36 and 5139.41 of the Revised Code to modify the formula for grants to counties from the department of youth services to operate community corrections facilities for felony delinquents.

**H. B. No. 728** - Representatives Odioso, Plummer.

To amend sections 2151.35 and 2152.11 of the Revised Code to eliminate informal hearings and dismissals in the best interest of the child in certain juvenile delinquency cases.

**H. B. No. 729** - Representatives Hall, T., Miller, K.

To enact section 5534.932 of the Revised Code to designate Interstate 75 in Butler County as the "Patrolman Earnest E. Cole Memorial Highway."

**H. B. No. 730** - Representative Stewart.

To make capital reappropriations for the biennium ending June 30, 2028.

**H. B. No. 731** - Representative Bird.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.947 of the Revised Code to create the "Land of U.S. Grant" license plate.

**H. B. No. 732** - Representative Miller, M.

Cosponsors: Representatives Salvo, Johnson, Gross, Brennan, Hiner, Robb Blasdel, Brewer.

To enact section 122.074 of the Revised Code to create the Ohio, The Heart of It All Pass program under TourismOhio.

**H. B. No. 733** - Representatives Fowler Arthur, Thomas, D.

To amend sections 1.61, 303.01, 519.01, 901.511, 929.01, 1311.55, 1729.01, and 5501.50 of the Revised Code to expressly include the production of maple syrup and maple products in the laws relating to agriculture.

**H. B. No. 734** - Representative Fowler Arthur.

To enact section 3302.27 of the Revised Code to establish the Outstanding Citizenship Award designation on the state report card and to make an appropriation.

Said bills were considered the first time.
