INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 842 - Representative Brent.

To enact section 5.079 of the Revised Code to designate Celestine as Ohio's official mineral.

H. B. No. 843 - Representative Craig.

To amend sections 4511.092, 4511.093, 4511.096, 4511.097, 4511.098, 4511.099, and 4511.0911; to enact new section 4511.094; and to repeal sections 4511.094, 4511.095, 4511.0912, 4511.0913, and 4511.0914 of the Revised Code to require elector approval for a municipal traffic camera program and to streamline the traffic camera laws.

H. B. No. 844 - Representatives Click, Mathews, T.

Cosponsor: Representative Mullins.

To amend sections 107.036 and 5747.98 and to enact sections 122.863 and 5747.88 of the Revised Code to authorize an income tax credit for businesses that make qualifying technology investments.

H. B. No. 845 - Representative Craig.

To enact sections 3902.75, 3902.751, 3902.752, 3902.753, 3902.754, and 3902.755 of the Revised Code regarding dental benefit plans.

H. B. No. 846 - Representatives Thomas, C., Plummer.

Cosponsors: Representatives Troy, Brewer, Brennan, Lett.

To enact section 2919.252 of the Revised Code to create the repeat domestic violence offender registry.

H. B. No. 847 - Representatives Jarrells, Williams.

Cosponsor: Representative Rogers.

To amend sections 3314.03, 3326.11, and 3328.24 and to enact section 3313.675 of the Revised Code to enact the Return to Learn Act regarding

return-to-school support policies after a traumatic brain injury.

To enact section 5.2325 of the Revised Code to designate the month of September as "Celebrate HBCU Month."

H. B. No. 849 - Representatives Plummer, Salvo.

To amend sections 9.681, 3313.751, 3794.05, 5502.01, 5502.13, 5502.14, 5502.99, 5743.01, 5743.54, and 5743.61 and to enact sections 2935.034, 5502.80, 5502.81, 5502.82, 5502.83, 5743.541, 5743.611, 5743.74, and 5743.75 of the Revised Code regarding the regulation, registration, licensure, inspection, and enforcement of electronic smoking, tobacco, nicotine, and vapor products retailers.
