INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 984 - Representatives Pizzulli, Brewer.

To amend section 5180.42 of the Revised Code to require the Department of Children and Youth to set reimbursement rates for the placement and care of children in foster care and to declare an emergency.

H. B. No. 985 - Representative Mathews, T.

To amend sections 303.12, 504.14, 519.12, and 731.29 of the Revised Code to modify local referenda and initiative signature requirements.
