INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 809 - Representatives Miller, M., Sweeney.

Cosponsors: Representatives Piccolantonio, Brennan, Lett, Salvo, Ritter, Gross.

To amend sections 3721.60, 3721.61, 3721.63, and 3721.65 of the Revised Code to make changes regarding electronic monitoring of a resident's room in a long-term care facility.

H. B. No. 810 - Representative Williams.

To enact sections 113.65 and 5166.38 of the Revised Code to establish the American Dream Voluntary Transition Program as a component of the Medicaid program and to designate this act the American Dream Act.

H. B. No. 811 - Representative Lett.

To amend section 5119.34 of the Revised Code regarding residential facilities licensed by the Department of Behavioral Health.

H. B. No. 812 - Representative Lorenz.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brennan, LaRe.

To enact section 5534.929 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 750 in Delaware County as the "Anastasia Jehorek Memorial Highway."
