The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 685 - Representatives Lett, Schmidt.

Cosponsors: Representatives Russo, Rader, Salvo, Brennan, Piccolantonio, White, A., Synenberg, Troy, Brent, Brownlee, Sims, Hall, D.

To enact sections 4301.73 and 4301.731 of the Revised Code to establish provisions governing date rape drug testing devices.

H. B. No. 686 - Representative Schmidt.

Cosponsors: Representatives Jarrells, Click, Odioso, White, E., Lett, Brennan, Daniels, John, Johnson, Deeter, Bird, Thomas, C.

To amend sections 2101.16, 2101.162, 2111.03, 2111.121, 2111.51, and 2113.031 and to enact section 3109.044 of the Revised Code to enact the Parker Kahle Act regarding guardianship of an adult child with a disability and the allocation of parental rights and responsibilities.

H. B. No. 687 - Representative Schmidt.

To amend section 3701.851 and to enact section 3701.852 of the Revised Code regarding staffing requirements in athletic facilities with staff trained in automated external defibrillation and cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

H. B. No. 688 - Representatives Tims, Brent.

To enact section 4113.87 of the Revised Code to prohibit private employers from including on an employment application any question concerning the criminal background of the applicant.

H. B. No. 689 - Representative White, A.

To amend sections 109.57, 109.60, 2953.32, and 5122.311 of the Revised Code and to amend Section 221.40 of H.B. 96 of the 136th General Assembly, as subsequently amended, to align and modernize fingerprinting and disposition reporting.

H. B. No. 690 - Representatives Young, White, A.

Cosponsor: Representative Willis.

To amend sections 2903.06, 2903.08, 2903.081, and 2903.13 and to enact section 4511.461 of the Revised Code to establish penalties for failing to obey a school crossing guard and other associated offenses.

H. B. No. 691 - Representatives Brownlee, Thomas, C.

Cosponsors: Representatives Abdullahi, Baker, Brent, Brewer, Bryant Bailey, Cockley, Grim, Jarrells, Lett, McNally, Miller, J., Mohamed, Piccolantonio, Rader, Robinson, Russo, Sigrist, Sims, Somani, Upchurch, Synenberg, White, E.

To enact section 2921.50 of the Revised Code to enact the Community and Police Protection Act to regulate law enforcement officers' use of masks.

H. B. No. 692 - Representatives Pizzulli, John.

Cosponsors: Representatives Deeter, Salvo, Robb Blasdel, Young, Williams, Bird, Thomas, D., Hall, T., Daniels, Fischer, Moore, Ritter.

To amend sections 3718.02, 3718.021, 3718.11, 6111.44, and 6111.441 of the Revised Code to make changes to the law governing household sewage treatment systems.

H. B. No. 693 - Representatives Click, Williams.

Cosponsors: Representatives Mullins, Hall, T., Claggett, Lear, Swearingen, Gross, Salvo, King, John, Workman, Klopfenstein, Dean, Stephens.

To amend sections 2151.412, 2151.426, 3109.04, 3109.054, and 3129.01 and to enact sections 2151.032, 3129.10, 3129.11, 3129.12, 3129.13, 3129.14, 3129.15, 3129.21, 3129.211, 3129.22, 3129.23, 3129.24, 3129.25, 3129.26, 3129.30, 3129.301, 3129.35, 3129.351, and 4743.15 of the Revised Code to enact the Affirming Families First Act and protect the right to affirm a minor child's sex.

Said bills were considered the first time.
