The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 25, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Mathews, A. was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 813 - Representatives Cockley, Miller, J.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brennan, McNally, Piccolantonio, Lett, Synenberg, Brownlee, Brent, Russo.

To enact sections 1349.12, 1349.13, 1349.14, 1349.15, and 1349.16 of the Revised Code to require AI-generated products have a watermark and to require disclosure when AI-systems are acting as humans.

H. B. No. 814 - Representative Roemer.

To enact section 3704.142 of the Revised Code to eliminate E-Check if the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency determines that Ohio is in attainment with specified ambient air quality standards.

H. B. No. 815 - Representatives Russo, Rader.

Cosponsors: Representatives Piccolantonio, Brownlee, McNally, Miller, J.

To amend section 6111.041 and to enact section 6109.26 of the Revised Code to require the Director of Environmental Protection to adopt rules establishing maximum allowable contaminant levels in drinking water and water quality standards for certain contaminants.

H. B. No. 816 - Representatives Click, Lorenz.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brennan, Williams.

To amend section 5739.02 of the Revised Code to exempt service dogs and miniature horses from sales and use tax.

H. B. No. 817 - Representative Williams.

To create the NextGen Public Safety Pilot Program, to authorize Local Government Fund reductions if Lucas County or the City of Toledo fail to abide by certain terms of a grant under that Program, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 818 - Representative Ritter.

To enact sections 1751.64, 3923.66, 3923.67, and 5164.11 of the Revised Code regarding insurance and Medicaid coverage of scalp cooling systems for individuals receiving cancer chemotherapy treatments.

H. B. No. 819 - Representatives Rader, Synenberg.

Cosponsors: Representatives Piccolantonio, Lett, Brennan, Brownlee, Somani, Miller, J., Cockley, McNally.

To amend sections 1509.02, 1509.34, 5703.052, 5749.01, 5749.02, 5749.04, 5749.06, 5749.07, 5749.08, 5749.10, 5749.12, 5749.13, 5749.14, and 5749.15; to enact sections 4928.57 and 4928.571; and to repeal section 1509.50 of the Revised Code to modify the rate and revenue allocation of the severance tax on oil and natural gas, to create an electric bill credit, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 820 - Representative Deeter.

To amend sections 5747.98 and 5751.98 and to enact sections 3301.93, 3313.861, 3314.861, 3326.861, 3328.861, 5747.88, and 5751.55 of the Revised Code to require radon testing in school facilities, create home radon mitigation income and commercial activity tax credits, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 821 - Representatives Rader, Schmidt.

Cosponsors: Representatives Pizzulli, Brownlee, Brennan, Mathews, A., Abdullahi, Cockley, Fischer, Holmes.

To enact section 5.079 of the Revised Code to designate the Loveland Frog as the official state cryptid of Ohio.

H. B. No. 822 - Representative Click.

To amend sections 173.541 and 5163.33 of the Revised Code regarding the Medicaid personal needs allowance for individuals eligible for the Medicaid-funded assisted living program and for residents of nursing homes and ICFs/IID.

Said bills were considered the first time.
