INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 979 - Representative Klopfenstein.

To enact sections 4927.23, 4927.24, 4927.25, 4927.26, 4927.27, 4927.28, 4939.11, 4939.12, 4939.13, 4939.14, 4939.15, 4939.16, 4939.17, 5547.031, 5547.041, and 5589.101 of the Revised Code regarding broadband internet access service infrastructure located in a public right-of-way.

H. B. No. 980 - Representatives Grim, Baker.

Cosponsors: Representatives Synenberg, Lett, Brownlee, Somani, Brennan.

To amend sections 4925.02, 4925.03, 4925.04, and 4925.07 and to enact sections 4925.11, 4925.12, and 4925.99 of the Revised Code to revise the law governing transportation network companies and to name this act the Rideshare Sexual Assault Prevention Act.

H. B. No. 981 - Representative LaRe.

To amend section 715.72 of the Revised Code regarding the maximum income tax that can be levied in a joint economic development district.
