The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 1013 - Representative Newman.

To amend sections 2151.233, 2151.235, 2151.27, 3105.011, 3109.04, and 3109.06 and to enact section 3109.402 of the Revised Code to enact the Family Sovereignty Act to prohibit awarding custody of a child to a non-parent when the child's parents are married to each other and maintaining a family unit and to limit who may file a complaint alleging abuse, neglect, or dependency.

H. B. No. 1014 - Representatives Rader, Thomas, D.

Cosponsors: Representatives Cockley, Pizzulli, Glassburn, Brennan, Somani, Upchurch, Miller, J., Troy, Sims, Lett, Piccolantonio, McNally, Bryant Bailey, Synenberg, Manning, Sweeney.

To enact sections 4928.106, 4928.107, 4928.108, 4928.109, 4928.1010, 4928.1011, and 4928.1012 of the Revised Code to require bill credits and customer reimbursements after certain power outages.

H. B. No. 1015 - Representative King.

To enact section 5534.632 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of the interchange of U.S. Route 33 and State Route 66 in Auglaize County as the "Sgt. Eli Holsinger Memorial Interchange."

H. B. No. 1016 - Representative Manning.

To enact section 5534.623 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 57 in Lorain County as the "Army Sgt. Daniel Michael Shepherd Memorial Highway."

Said bills were considered the first time.
