INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 709 - Representatives Brownlee, Craig.

To amend section 3902.30 of the Revised Code to require private insurers to cover telehealth services for mental health services the same as for in-person mental health services.

H. B. No. 710 - Representatives Demetriou, Workman.

To amend section 163.01 and to enact sections 9.71, 9.711, and 4933.71 of the Revised Code to prohibit public support for, and limit the construction of, new data centers.

To amend section 3317.13 of the Revised Code regarding the minimum teacher salary schedule.

H. B. No. 712 - Representative Craig.

To enact section 3901.93 of the Revised Code to create within the Department of Insurance an all-payer claims database.

H. B. No. 717 - Representative Dean.

To amend section 4517.02 of the Revised Code to increase the number of vehicles, from five to fifteen, that a person may sell without obtaining a motor vehicle dealer license if the vehicles are over 12 years old.
