The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 469 - Senator Cutrona.

To amend section 149.43 and to enact sections 5507.01, 5507.02, 5507.03, 5507.04, 5507.05, and 5507.99 of the Revised Code to regulate the use of automated license plate recognition systems, mass surveillance technology, and captured surveillance data.

S. B. No. 470 - Senator Roegner.

To enact section 5534.156 of the Revised Code to designate the bridge spanning the Cuyahoga River on State Route 8 as the "First Lieutenant Ronald Yale, USMC, Memorial Bridge."

S. B. No. 471 - Senators DeMora, Craig.

Cosponsors: Senators Liston, Smith, Brenner.

To amend section 2301.02 of the Revised Code to add two judges to the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas to be elected in 2028.
