S. B. No. 472 - Senator Craig.

To enact section 5534.506 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of U.S. Route 62 in Columbus as the "State Senator I. Ray Miller Jr. Memorial Highway."

To urge the United States Congress to oppose proposed changes to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.
