The bill requires the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) to create three new notifications regarding the Medicaid Estate Recovery Program. These are notice that the program exists, notice of how the program works, and notice of resources available for consumer support. The bill requires these notices be given to new Medicaid applicants twice: once at application and once at approval. Approval must also be accompanied by instructions on how to file a complaint with ODM, how to inquire about the status of benefits, and instructions on how to disenroll from Medicaid. The bill also requires ODM to adopt rules ensuring compliance.

ODM will incur administrative costs to create documents and update rules.
