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**"Section 3.** All items in this act are hereby appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all operating appropriations made in this act, those in the first column are for fiscal year 2026 and those in the second column are for fiscal year 2027. The operating appropriations made in this act are in addition to any other operating appropriations made for these fiscal years.

The foregoing appropriation item 768425, Justice Program 15  
Services, shall be used by the Office of Criminal Justice 16  
Services to award grants to local governments for pilot projects 17  
regarding new safety, notice, and procedures during planned or 18  
emergent road responses to improve the safety related to the 19  
enforcement of section 4511.213 of the Revised Code, commonly 20  
known as the "Move Over Law." Each grant recipient shall report 21  
findings back to the Office of Criminal Justice Services to be a 22  
resource for other jurisdictions around the state. 23

An amount equal to the unexpended, unencumbered balance of 24  
the foregoing appropriation item 768425, Justice Program 25  
Services, at the end of fiscal year 2026 is hereby 26  
reappropriated to the same appropriation item for the same 27  
purposes in fiscal year 2027. 28

**Section 5.** Within the limits set forth in this act, the 29  
Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 30  
indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 31  
made in this act, and shall determine the manner in which 32  
appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures from 33  
operating appropriations contained in this act shall be 34  
accounted for as though made in, and are subject to all 35  
applicable provisions of, H.B. 96 of the 136th General 36
