BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.212 of the Revised Code be	4
enacted to read as follows:	5

<u>Sec. 5.212. The ninth day of March is designated as</u>	6

<u>who served in the 6888th central postal directory battalion, the</u>	8
