Local Impact Statement Procedure Required: No

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The bill has no direct fiscal effect on the state or political subdivisions. Minimum prices of alcohol are generally set by the Liquor Control Commission (LCO) under current law. LCO is also required to allow retailers to offer a 10% per-bottle discount on a case of wine sold under current law. The bill requires that LCO permit the same retail discount on each bottle of dealcoholized (less than 0.5% alcohol by volume) beverage offered for sale if that beverage is purchased as part of the same transaction where a person is buying a case of wine.

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
