## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5502.54 of the Revised Code be	3
enacted to read as follows:	4
Sec. 5502.54. (A) "Law enforcement agency" means an	5
organization or unit made up of law enforcement officers as	6
defined in section 2901.01 of the Revised Code.	7
(B)(1) The escaped convict alert program is created to aid	8
in the identification and location of any person who was	9
convicted of or pleaded guilty to a felony offense or was	10
indicted or otherwise charged with the commission of a felony	11
offense who has escaped from a jail, workhouse, or correctional	12
institution while incarcerated for or awaiting adjudication of	13
that felony offense. For purposes of this section, a jail,	14
workhouse, or correctional institution does not include a	15

community-based correctional facility or halfway house.	16		
(2) A law enforcement agency that receives a notice	17		
pursuant to section 341.011, 753.19, or 5120.14 of the Revised	18		
Code regarding a person who was convicted of or pleaded guilty	19		
to a felony offense or was indicted or otherwise charged with	20		
the commission of a felony offense may activate the escaped	21		
convict alert program for the surrounding area or region of the	22		
jail, workhouse, or correctional institution from which the	23		
person has escaped.	24		
(C) Nothing in division (B) of this section prevents the	25		
activation of a local or regional alert program that may impose	26		
different criteria for the activation of a local or regional	27		
alert.	28		
(D) Any radio broadcast station, television broadcast	29		
station, or cable system participating in the escaped convict	30		
alert program or in any local or regional alert program, and any	31		
director, officer, employee, or agent of any station or system	32		
participating in either type of alert program, shall not be	33		
liable to any person for damages for any loss allegedly caused	34		
by or resulting from the station's or system's broadcast or	35		
cablecast of, or failure to broadcast or cablecast, any	36		
information pursuant to the escaped convict alert program or the	37		
local or regional alert program.	38		
(E) Nothing in this section shall be construed to	39		
authorize the use of the federal emergency alert system unless	40		
otherwise authorized by federal law.
