Eliminates the penalty in the As Introduced version 35
applicable when a state agency or political subdivision fails to 36
include provisions that comply with the bill in a contract for 37
the construction or renovation of a nonresidential construction 38
contract entered into by the agency or political subdivision. 39

Requires the Attorney General to notify a state agency and 40

the Director of Administrative Services of any contract the 41
Attorney General identifies as not including the required 42
provisions. 43

Requires, for a period of one year, a state agency that 44
fails to include required provisions to submit any 45
nonresidential construction contract proposed by the state 46
agency to the DAS Director. 47

Requires the DAS Director to promptly review a submitted 48
proposed contract and determine whether it includes the required 49
provisions, notify the state agency of the determination, and, 50
if the contract does not contain the provisions, instruct the 51
state agency to revise the proposed contract. 52
