Section 1. That sections 2911.11, 2911.12, and 2911.13 of	6

(1) "Occupied structure" has the same meaning as in	23

meanings as in section 2923.11 of the Revised Code.	26

guilty of burglary. A violation of division (A)(1) or (2) of	53

division (A)(3) of this section is a felony of the third degree.	55	
(E) Whoever violates division (B) of this section is	56	
guilty of trespass in a habitation when a person is present or	57	
likely to be present, a felony of the fourth degree.	58	
Sec. 2911.13. (A) No person—by force, stealth, or	59	
deception, shall trespass in an unoccupied structure, with	60	
purpose to commit therein any theft offense, as defined in	61	
section 2913.01 of the Revised Code, or any felony.	62	
(B) No person shall trespass on the land or premises of	63	
another, with purpose to commit a felony.	64	
(C) Whoever violates this section is guilty of breaking	65	
and entering, a felony of the fifth degree.	66	
Section 2. That existing sections 2911.11, 2911.12, and	67	
2911.13 of the Revised Code are hereby repealed.	68
