To amend section 4507.09 of the Revised Code to 1 require the Registrar of Motor Vehicles send a 2 notice prior to a driver's license expiring, 3 rather than after expiration. 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4507.09 of the Revised Code be	5							
amended to read as follows:	6							
Sec. 4507.09. (A)(1) Except as provided in division (B) of	7							
this section, every driver's license issued to a resident of	8							
this state expires on the birthday of the applicant in the	9							
fourth or eighth year after the date it is issued, based on the	10							
period of renewal requested by the applicant. A resident who is	11							
sixty-five years of age or older may only apply for a driver's	12							
license that expires on the birthday of the applicant in the	13							
fourth year after the date it is issued. In no event shall any	14							
license be issued for a period longer than eight years and								
ninety days.	16							
Subject to the requirements of section 4507.12 of the	17							
Revised Code, every driver's license issued to a resident is	18							
renewable at any time prior to its expiration.	19							
(2) A driver's license issued to a temporary resident	20							

shall expire in accordance with rules adopted by the registrar of motor vehicles. A driver's license issued to a temporary resident is a limited term license, but may be renewed within ninety days prior to its expiration in accordance with division (E) of this section.

(3) No refund shall be made or credit given for the unexpired portion of the driver's license that is renewed. The registrar shall notify send a notification to each person whose driver's license has expired within forty-five is scheduled to expire not less than fourteen days after prior to the date of expiration. Notification shall be made by regular mail sent to the person's last known address as shown in the records of the bureau of motor vehicles. Failure to provide such notification shall not be construed as a renewal or extension of any license.

(4) For the purposes of this section, the date of birth of any applicant born on the twenty-ninth day of February shall be deemed to be the first day of March in any year in which there is no twenty-ninth day of February.

(B) Every driver's license or renewal of a driver's license issued to a resident applicant who is sixteen years of age or older, but less than twenty-one years of age, expires on the twenty-first birthday of the applicant, except that an applicant who applies no more than thirty days before the applicant's twenty-first birthday shall be issued a license in accordance with division (A) of this section.

(C) Each person licensed as a driver under this chapter
shall notify the registrar of any change in the person's address
within ten days following that change. The notification shall be
in writing on a form provided by the registrar and shall include
the full name, date of birth, license number, county of

residence, social security number, and new address of the 51 person. The registrar shall offer the person the opportunity to 52 submit a notice of change of address for voter registration 53 purposes by electronic means in conjunction with the person's 54 transaction with the registrar, in accordance with section 55 3503.11 of the Revised Code. 56

(D) No driver's license shall be renewed when renewal is prohibited by division (A) of section 4507.091 of the Revised Code.

(E) (1) Except as provided in division (E) (2) of this
section, a limited term license shall not be issued to a
temporary resident for a period longer than the expiration date
of the temporary resident's authorized stay in the United
States, or for four years from the date of issuance, whichever
date is earliest.

(2) If there is no expiration date for a temporary

resident's authorized stay in the United States, a limited term
67
license shall not be issued to the temporary resident for a

period longer than one year from the date of issuance.

(3) A limited term license may be renewed within ninety
70
days prior to its expiration upon the applicant's presentation
71
of documentation verifying the applicant's legal presence or
72
continued temporary lawful status in the United States.

(3) (4)A limited term license is not transferable, and the74applicant may not rely on it to obtain a driver's license in75another state.76

(4)(5)In accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised77Code, the registrar shall adopt rules governing limited term78licenses for temporary residents.79
