BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 2917.43 of the Revised Code be	6
enacted to read as follows:	
Sec. 2917.43. (A) As used in this section:	8
(1) "Cloud seeding" means a form of weather modification	9
where a pollutant is released into clouds to induce or enhance	10
precipitation.	11
(2) "Marine cloud brightening" means enhancing the	12
reflectivity of low-lying marine clouds to reflect more	
sunlight.	14
(3) "Pollutant" means any aerosol; biologic,	15
transbiologic, or genetically modified agent; chaff; metal;	
radioactive material; acid; alkali; chemical; particulate;	
contaminant; smart dust; smoke; soot; fume; vapor; air pollutant	

regulated by this state; mechanical vibration or other physical	19
agent; waste, including materials that may be recycled,	20
reconditioned, or reclaimed; solid, liquid, gaseous, or thermal	21
irritant; or artificially produced electric field, magnetic	22
field, electromagnetic field, electromagnetic pulse, sound wave,	23
sound pollution, light pollution, microwave, or ionizing or non-	24
ionizing radiation.	25
(4) "Solar radiation modification" means an experiment in	26
the earth's climatic system involving the release of pollutants	27
that reduces the amount of sunlight absorbed by the earth,	28
including through marine cloud brightening, space-based	29
reflectors, or stratospheric aerosol injection.	30
(5) "Space-based reflectors" means deploying mirrors or	31
other reflective objects in space to deflect sunlight.	32
(6) "Stratospheric aerosol injection" means introducing	33
reflective particles into the stratosphere to reflect sunlight.	34
(B) No person or entity shall engage in solar radiation	35
modification, cloud seeding, or sunlight reflection methods in	36
this state, including through the use of an aircraft, balloon,	37
drone, space-based platform, or interoperable ground-based	38
facility.	39
(C) The superintendent of the state highway patrol or a	40
county sheriff shall issue a cease-and-desist order to a person	41
who the superintendent or sheriff determines is conducting or	42
attempting to conduct solar radiation modification, cloud	43
seeding, or sunlight reflection methods. No person shall fail to	44
comply with a cease and desist order issued under this division.	45
(D) A violation of this section is a strict liability	46
offense and section 2901.20 of the Revised Code does not apply.	47

(E) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a third	48
degree felony and the court shall impose a mandatory prison term	49
of thirty-six months on the offender and, notwithstanding	50
section 2929.18 of the Revised Code, a fine of not less than	51
five hundred thousand dollars.	52
Section 2. This act shall be known as the Atmosphere	53
Protection Act.	54
