SYNOPSIS

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Approved nationally standardized assessments

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R.C. 3301.0712

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Permits public and chartered nonpublic schools to
administer *any* nationally standardized assessment by eliminating
the requirement that the Department of Education and Workforce
and the Chancellor of Higher Education jointly select the
assessments from which schools must choose.

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Expressly permits a district to choose to administer the
ACT, SAT, Classic Learning Test, or any other valid, reliable,
nationally norm-referenced exam used for college admission.

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**Assessments used for admission to state institutions of
higher education**

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R.C. 3345.065

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Requires each state institution of higher education that
accepts any of the ACT, SAT, Classic Learning Test, or any other
valid, reliable, nationally norm-referenced college entrance
exam to accept all of those assessments for admission.

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
