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To establish a grant program to reimburse local	1
government entities for the acquisition,	2
development, and rehabilitation of community	3
recreation spaces, to name this act the Fit,	4
Safe, and Strong Communities Act, and to make an	5
appropriation.	6

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

<b>Section 1.</b> (A) The Director of Children and Youth shall	7
establish and administer, with the assistance of the Director of	8
Natural Resources, a one-time grant program that provides up to	9
seventy-five per cent reimbursement to local government entities	10
for the acquisition, development, or rehabilitation of outdoor	11
spaces, parks, playgrounds, pools, splash pads, and recreation	12
centers.	13

(B) A local government entity, including a township,	14
village, city, county, park district, joint recreation district,	15
and conservancy district may apply to the Director of Children	16
and Youth for a grant under this section. The applicant shall	17
include the following in the application:	18

(1) Proof that the applicant holds the title to or has a	19
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non-revocable lease of at least fifteen years to the property 20  
listed for the grant; 21

(2) A plan that details the proposed development or 22  
rehabilitation of the property; 23

(3) A plan to partner with a nonprofit organization or 24  
community partner for the development of the property. 25

(C) Local government entities applying for a grant under 26  
this section shall be given priority if they include either of 27  
the following in the application: 28

(1) A plan developed with a nonprofit organization or 29  
community partner that includes initiatives to create play area 30  
capacity within their communities, including how to create 31  
ongoing sustainability to support capacity-expanding initiatives 32  
and identify the needs it would address; 33

(2) A plan to develop a learning lab on the property. 34

(D) As used in this section, "learning lab" means a 35  
dedicated space within a facility designed for educational 36  
activities that focus on teaching new skills, promoting 37  
knowledge of health and wellness, or providing technology 38  
training in an accessible setting for engagement by all members 39  
of the community. 40

**Section 2.** All items in this act are hereby appropriated 41  
as designated out of any moneys in the state treasury to the 42  
credit of the designated fund. For all operating appropriations 43  
made in this act, those in the first column are for fiscal year 44  
2026 and those in the second column are for fiscal year 2027. 45  
The operating appropriations made in this act are in addition to 46  
any other operating appropriations made for these fiscal years. 47

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## COMMUNITY PROJECTS AND ASSISTANCE

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Of the foregoing appropriation item 830420, Community  
Projects and Assistance, \$10,000,000 in each fiscal year shall  
be used for the grant program to provide reimbursement to local  
government entities for the acquisition, development, or  
rehabilitation of outdoor spaces, parks, playgrounds, pools,  
splash pads, and recreation centers described in Section 1 of  
this act.

Of the foregoing appropriation item 830420, Community  
Projects and Assistance, \$250,000 in each fiscal year shall be  
used to establish learning labs within local government  
subdivision recreation centers.

**Section 4.** Within the limits set forth in this act, the  
Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts  
indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation

made in this act, and shall determine the manner in which 66  
appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures from 67  
operating appropriations contained in this act shall be 68  
accounted for as though made in, and are subject to all 69  
applicable provisions of, the main operating appropriations act 70  
of the 136th General Assembly. 71

**Section 5.** This act shall be known as the Fit, Safe, and 72  
Strong Communities Act. 73
