"Sec. 3717.55. (A) As used in this section: 7

(1) "Chain food service operation" means a food service 8
operation that is part of a chain of establishments with twenty 9
or more locations doing business under the same name, regardless 10
of the type of ownership of the locations, and offering for sale 11
substantially similar menu items. 12

(2) "High sodium content" means when any standard menu 13
item offered by a chain food service operation that contains 14
fifty per cent or more per serving of the daily reference value 15
used by the secretary of health and human services to calculate 16

<u>under 21 C.F.R. 101.9(c) as of January 1, 2025.</u>	18
<u>(3) "Menu" or "menu board" means the primary writing of a</u>	19
<u>chain food service operation from which a customer makes an</u>	20
<u>order selection.</u>	21
<u>(4) "Menus on the internet" include menus on a chain food</u>	22
<u>service operation's web site and application, and on third-party</u>	23
<u>platforms when a chain food service operation posts and controls</u>	24
<u>the menu posted on that platform.</u>	25
<u>(5) "Point of selection" means a place where a customer</u>	26
<u>may view menu options and make the customer's selection when</u>	27
<u>purchasing food from a chain food service operation.</u>	28

<u>(B) Not later than one year after the effective date of</u>	39
<u>this section, the director of health shall adopt rules in</u>	40
<u>accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code establishing a</u>	41
<u>high sodium warning icon and accompanying text to be displayed</u>	42
<u>next to the name of any standard menu item with high sodium</u>	43
<u>content.</u>	44

<u>(C) Not later than two years after the effective date of this section, the owner or operator of a chain food service operation shall display on the chain food service operation's menus or menu boards both of the following:</u>	45
<u>(1) In a clear and conspicuous manner, the high sodium warning icon and accompanying text established in rules adopted under this section immediately adjacent to each standard menu item with high sodium content. The icon and text shall be displayed at a height no smaller than the largest letter in the name of the item.</u>	49
<u>(2) The following factual warning statement explaining the high sodium warning icon and accompanying text: "[Insert icon and accompanying text here] indicates that the sodium (salt) content of this item exceeds half the total daily recommended limit. Diets higher in sodium are associated with an increased risk of developing high blood pressure, which is a major cause of heart disease and stroke."</u>	55
<u>The owner or operator shall display the factual warning statement prominently, clearly, and conspicuously at the point of selection.</u>	62
<u>(D) Not later than one year after the effective date of this section, the director shall publish on the department of health's web site guidance explaining the requirements of this section and rules adopted under it and the manner in which chain food service operations must comply with those requirements.</u>	65
<u>(E) (1) In the course of inspecting a chain food service operation, a licensor shall confirm that the operation is in compliance with this section.</u>	70
<u>(2) A licensor shall assess a civil penalty of not more</u>	73

than five hundred dollars for a violation of this section. Each 74
day is a separate violation for each location. A violator may 75
appeal the assessment in accordance with Chapter 119. of the 76
Revised Code. 77

(3) The director shall establish a process by which a 78
member of the public may submit a complaint regarding 79
noncompliance with this section. 80

(F) Not later than six years after the effective date of 81
this section, the director of health shall review evidence of 82
the impact of this section on standard menu item reformulation 83
and consumer behavior and issue a report. The director shall 84
publish the report on the department's web site. The director 85
shall include in the report recommendations of additional 86
nutrients that should be considered for menu warning icons." 87

Requires the owner or operator of a chain food service 96
operation to display on the operation's menus certain 97

information regarding high sodium content food, including the high sodium warning icon.	98
Requires a local board of health or the Director to inspect for compliance with the above requirements and to assess a civil penalty of up to \$500 for a violation.	100
Requires the Director to review evidence of the impact of the amendment's provisions on standard menu item reformulation and consumer behavior, and issue a report.	101
