## DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	“Detective Rex Emrick Memorial Highway” <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	State Route (S.R.) 56, between S.R. 316 and the Madison County line, in Pickaway County
<b>Other Information</b>	Detective Emrick began his law enforcement career with the Mount Sterling Police Department in April 1974. Beginning in 1976 and until his passing on January 26, 2021, he served at the Pickaway County Sheriff’s Office as a deputy sheriff and a detective.
