To enact section 5534.102 of the Revised Code to 1
designate a portion of U.S. Route 22 in Harrison 2
County as the "Staff Sergeant Melvin Trushel, 3
Sr. Memorial Highway." 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5534.102 of the Revised Code be 5
enacted to read as follows: 6

Sec. 5534.102. In addition to any other name prescribed in 7
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 8
of United States route number twenty-two between mile marker 9
nineteen and mile marker twenty-two, within Harrison county, 10
shall be known as the "Staff Sergeant Melvin Trushel, Sr. 11
Memorial Highway." 12

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 13
along the highway indicating its name. 14
