**Allowable uses of profits from jail commissary funds** 20

**R.C. 341.25** 21

Allows profits from the commissary fund to also be used 22  
for recreation, programming services, medication in relation to 23  
treatment and programming, to investigate allegations of staff 24  
misconduct, to purchase technology necessary for general safety, 25  
and to pay for advanced staff training of jail personnel. 26

Removes language added by the bill that allows profits 27  
from the commissary fund to be used for supplies and equipment 28  
necessary for jail operations if the purchased items exceed 29  
minimum required standards, and to cover emergency expenses for 30  
the jail facility if certain conditions are met, and to 31  
supplement costs for certain expenses of investigative personnel 32  
or units. 33
