To enact section 5534.448 of the Revised Code to	1
designate a portion of United States Route 6 in	2
Lorain County as the "Police Officer Phillip	3
Wagner Memorial Highway."	4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5534.448 of the Revised Code be	5
enacted to read as follows:	6

Sec. 5534.448. In addition to any other name prescribed in	7
<u>the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes</u>	8
<u>of United States route number six between state route number</u>	9
<u>fifty-eight and state route number fifty-seven, within the</u>	10
<u>municipal corporation of Lorain, in Lorain county, shall be</u>	11
<u>known as the "Police Officer Phillip Wagner Memorial Highway."</u>	12

<u>The director of transportation may erect suitable markers</u>	13
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along the highway indicating its name.

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
