BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:	
Section 1. That section 4561.50 be amended and section	5
4561.54 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 4561.50. As used in sections 4561.50 to 4561.53	7
4561.54 of the Revised Code:	8
(A) "Critical facility" means any of the following:	9
(1) A critical infrastructure facility as defined in	10
section 2911.21 of the Revised Code;	11
(2) A commercial distribution center;	12
(3) A federal, state, county, or municipal court;	13
(4) A police station, sheriff's office, state highway	14
patrol station, or premises controlled by the bureau of criminal	15
identification and investigation;	16
(5) A federal, state, county, or municipal jail or prison	17
or any other facility in which persons are incarcerated;	18

(6) A federal or state military installation or facility;	19
(7) A hospital that receives air ambulance services.	20
(B) "Unmanned aerial vehicle" means a powered, aerial	21
vehicle to which all of the following apply:	22
(1) The vehicle does not carry a human operator and is	23
operated without the possibility of direct human intervention	24
from within or on the vehicle;	25
(2) The vehicle uses aerodynamic forces to provide lift;	26
(3) The vehicle can fly autonomously or be piloted	27
remotely;	28
(4) The vehicle is either expendable or recoverable.	29
"Unmanned aerial vehicle" is commonly referred to as a	30
drone and does not include a satellite.	31
(C) "Unmanned aerial vehicle system" means an unmanned	32
aerial vehicle and associated elements, including communication	33
links and components that control the unmanned aerial vehicle	34
and that are required for the remote pilot in command to operate	35
the vehicle in the air space over this state.	36
(D) "Park district" means a park district created in	37
accordance with Chapter 1545. of the Revised Code.	38
Sec. 4561.54. (A) No person, without privilege to do so,	39
shall knowingly operate an unmanned aerial vehicle system in the	40
air space above the land or premises of another.	41
(B) No person, without privilege to do so, shall	42
recklessly operate an unmanned aerial vehicle system in the air	43
space above the land or premises of another when a notice	44
against unauthorized access to such land or premises is given	45

through one of the following:	46
(1) Actual communication to the person;	47
(2) A notice that is posted in a manner reasonably	48
calculated to come to the attention of potential intruders;	49
(3) By fencing or another form of enclosure manifestly	50
designed to restrict access.	51
(C) No person, without privilege to do so, shall	52
negligently continue to operate an unmanned aerial vehicle	53
system in the air space above the land or premises of another	54
after being given a direct notification to leave that air space	55
by the owner or occupant of the property.	56
(D) No person, without privilege to do so, shall knowingly	57
use an unmanned aerial vehicle system to videotape, film,	58
photograph, broadcast, stream, capture audio, or otherwise	59
record another person, in a place where that person has a	60
reasonable expectation of privacy.	61
(E) No person, without privilege to do so, shall knowingly	62
use an unmanned aerial vehicle system to videotape, film,	63
<pre>photograph, broadcast, stream, capture audio, or otherwise</pre>	64
record another person's private property, including any animals	65
or objects on another person's private property.	66
(F) No person, without privilege to do so, shall knowingly	67
use an unmanned aerial vehicle system to deploy any substance,	68
<pre>material, projectile, or object.</pre>	69
(G) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a fourth	70
degree misdemeanor.	71
Section 2. That existing section 4561.50 of the Revised	72
Code is hereby repealed.	73
