expenses for a decedent to be reimbursed from the decedent's	28
estate regardless of whether a reimbursement claim was filed.	29

Provides that a funeral home, burial provider, and	30
cemetery are entitled to payment from the estate of a decedent	31
if expenses are unpaid regardless of whether a payment claim was	32
filed.	33

Requires payment or reimbursement from the decedent's	34
estate for funeral, burial, and cemetery expenses to be limited	35
to the allowable amount under Ohio law if the estate of the	36
decedent is insolvent.	37
