Section 1. That section 121.17 be amended and section 4 121.171 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 5 Sec. 121.17. (A) Under the direction of the governor, the 6 7 directors of departments shall devise a practical and working basis for co-operation and co-ordination of work and for the elimination of duplication and overlapping functions. They shall co-operate with each other in the employment of services and the 10 use of quarters and equipment. The director of any department 11 may empower or require an employee of another department, 12 subject to the consent of the superior officer of the employee, 1.3 to perform any duty which he the director might require of his 14 the director's own subordinates. 15 (B) The directors of departments shall provide assistance 16 to the state government efficiency commission established under 17 section 121.171 of the Revised Code and shall cooperate and 18 coordinate to eliminate duplication and overlapping functions 19

The report shall be submitted not later than the first day of	33

(D) Members of the commission who are members of the	48
general assembly shall serve terms on the commission concurrent	49
with their term in the general assembly.	50
(E) A member of the commission may be removed at the will	51
of the member's appointing authority. Vacancies shall be filled	52

(F) The affirmative vote of not fewer than four members of	54
the commission is required for any action of the commission.	55
(G) Members of the commission are not entitled to	56
compensation, but shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary	57
expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties on	58
