Charlie Kirk American Heritage Act 29

R.C. 3302.09; R.C. 3314.03, 3320.10, 3320.11, 3326.11, and 30
3328.24 (all removed) 31

Changes the declaration statement as follows: 32

(1) States that the General Assembly finds and declares 33
that "The teaching *and debating* of the historical impact *and* 34
role of religion on *United States and Ohio history using* 35
multiple perspectives and credible sources consistent with Ohio 36

<i>academic standards and constitutional requirements is consistent</i>	37
with the First Amendment of the United States Constitution."	38
(2) Removes language that states, "An accurate and	39
historical account of the influence of Christianity on the	40
freedom and liberties ingrained in our culture is imperative to	41
reducing ignorance of American history, hate, and violence	42
within our society."	43
Removes provisions that permit teachers in public schools	44
and instructors at state institutions of higher education, when	45
providing instruction on American history, to also provide	46
instruction on the positive impacts of religion on American	47
history and include certain historical accounts.	48
