Technical amendment 21

R.C. 2953.321 and 2953.323 22

Provides that any dismissed complaint, indictment, or 23
information may be sealed under the bill's new sealing mechanism 24
by removing an erroneous reference to R.C. 2953.33(C) (1). R.C. 25
2953.33(C) (1) lists offenses that may not be expunged, rather 26
than offenses that may not be sealed. 27

Replaces the term "offender" with the term "person." 28

Removes an erroneous reference to "bail forfeiture." 29

Replaces the term "offender" with the term "applicant." 30
