Permits a school district that offers a National Defense 28
Cadet Corps (NDCC) program approved by the secretary of a 29
military department of the U.S. Armed Forces to designate that 30
program as part of the district's career-technical education 31
(CTE) program. 32

Requires the Department of Education and Workforce to 33
calculate career-technical education (CTE) funding for a Junior 34
Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) program designated as a 35
CTE program by a school district, rather than requiring it to 36
approve a JROTC program under its CTE program approval process. 37

Requires the Department to calculate CTE funding for an 38
NDCC program designated as a CTE program by a school district. 39
