Sec. 3313.907. A school district that offers a junior	7
reserve officer training corps (JROTC) program approved by the	8
congress of the United States under Title 10 of the United	9
States Code may designate that program as part of the district's	10
career-technical education program under section 3313.90 of the	11
Revised Code.	12
Sec. 3317.166. The department of education and workforce	13
and each lead district, as defined in section 3317.023 of the	14
Revised Code, shall approve as a career-technical education	15
program under section 3317.161 of the Revised Code any junior	16
reserve officer training corps (JROTC) program approved by the	17
congress of the United States under Title 10 of the United	18
