The Board of Nursing will not realize any fiscal impact due to the provision in the bill. The bill converts the Board of Nursing's advisory body on advanced practice registered nursing from an advisory committee to an advisory group. The bill also makes technical corrections, conforming changes, and clarifications in various statutes regarding the Board and the professionals it regulates. However, one clarification or correction repeals Section 105.40 of H.B. 33 of the 135th General Assembly, which is the sunset clause that eliminates, after five years of existence, the laws regarding Medicaid coverage of doula services and the Board of Nursing's certification of doulas. In H.B. 33, the Governor vetoed language that refers to the five-year time limit of the doula provisions; however, the provision that executes the sunset clause was not vetoed and, therefore, remains in existence. As a result, the intended status of the doula provisions after five years is currently unclear. This bill repeals this section, so the sunset clause is eliminated, which ensures these provisions continue beyond five years.
