DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"PFC Francis Guillozet Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The northeastbound and southwestbound lanes of State Route (S.R.) 47 between Simon Road and S.R. 66, in Shelby County
Other Information	PFC Francis Guillozet served in the United States Army during World War II. On March 14, 1945, he was killed in action in Germany. Among other commendations, PFC Guillozet was a recipient of the Purple Heart.
