SUMMARY

- Prohibits a state institution of higher education from awarding foreign students more than 25% of an intercollegiate athletic program's scholarships, grants, or similar forms of financial assistance that are conditioned on participation in that program in any academic year.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Intercollegiate athletic program scholarships

For each intercollegiate athletic program, the bill prohibits a state institution of higher education from awarding students who are citizens of a foreign country more than 25% of the program's scholarships, grants, or similar forms of financial assistance that are conditioned on participation in that program in any academic year. In other words, the bill limits a state institution's athletic scholarships for a program to foreign students to 25% of its total athletic scholarships for that program.¹
