The bill has minimal administrative cost impact. It requires the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) to adopt rules establishing a process for the Department to make available community capital assistance funds to assist county boards of developmental disabilities to acquire housing for individuals receiving supported living. The bill places conditions on what the rules should and should not allow, and specifies that residents who will be living in housing acquired or constructed using community capital assistance funds be given a meaningful opportunity to participate in selecting the type of housing. The bill does not require spending or change an appropriation. The expected fiscal impact is minimal administrative costs as the Director determines and enacts new rules.
